_____ it is hereby Ordered that the hearing scheduled in this matter shall be continued until _____, the _____ day of _____, 20____, at _____ o'clock __.m. in Courtroom #_____, Lancaster County Courthouse, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. All other provisions of the Temporary Protective Order dated _____, shall remain in force and effect until further Order of the Court.

The Respondent is hereby notified that if s/he violates this Order, s/he may be held in indirect criminal contempt which is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 and by a sentence of up to six (6) months in jail and by other possible relief. Beginning to live, or resumption of living, at a residence from which the Respondent is excluded by this Order could result in a finding of indirect criminal contempt. Consent of the Petitioner to resume contact or cohabitation does not invalidate, nullify, or void the provisions of this Order regarding the prohibitions against further abuse. Further, any violation of this Order may also constitute a crime under the Pennsylvania Criminal Code, and those penalties may be in addition to those imposed as contempt pursuant to this Order.
