

# EAST COCALICO TOWNSHIP

January 11, 2012

Due to the PennDOT Route 272 bridge construction (the bridge over the railroad and the bridge over Cocalico Creek), the road will be open from time to time, however when closed, detours will be posted. The township has installed signs prohibiting trucks on the following roads (except for local deliveries):

1. Wabash Road (TR669) between South Reamstown Road (TR700) and South Line Road (SR1045),
2. Pfautz Hill Road (TR745) between North Reading Road (SR0272) and Stevens Road (SR1030),
3. Cocalico Creek Road (TR747) between North Reading Road (SR0272) and South Reamstown Road (TR700),
4. South Reamstown Road (TR700) between Church Street (SR1051) and the East Cocalico Township line,
5. Ridge Avenue (TR937) between Church Street (SR1051) and Glenwood Drive (SR1049),
6. Stevens Road (SR1030) between South Line Road (SR1045) and Church Street (SR1051),
7. Glenwood Drive (TR670) between South Reamstown Road (TR700) and Valley View Drive (SR1049),
8. Ebersole Road (TR746) between South Reamstown Road (TR700) and Ridge Avenue (TR937),
9. Ream Road (TR714) between South Reamstown Road (TR700) and Ridge Avenue (TR937).
