ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE NO. – 10 – 2009

ADMINISTRATION BILL NO. 10 - 2009

INTRODUCED –JUNE 9, 2009

ADOPTED BY COUNCIL –JUNE 23, 2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING THAT ANY AND ALL FEES SET FORTH IN ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER OR THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER MAY BE AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME BY RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS PROVIDED BY PENNSYLVANIA LAW.

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lancaster has, from time to time adopted Ordinances which establish fees for City services; and

WHEREAS, many of such Ordinances have been codified into the City Code of the City of Lancaster; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lancaster desires to authorize the modification of any and all such fees by Resolution adopted by City Council from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further desires to authorize the establishment of additional fees for the administration of City affairs by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. City Council of the City of Lancaster be and hereby is authorized to modify any and all fees heretofore or hereafter established by Ordinance and, whether codified in the Code of the City of Lancaster or not, by Resolution.

SECTION 2. City Council of the City of Lancaster may, by Resolution, from to time authorize, establish and implement fees for the administration of City services.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions insofar as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and rescinded.

SECTION 4. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance; it being the intent of the City of Lancaster that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
