**ADMINISTRATION BILL NO. 13 - 2009**

**INTRODUCED –OCTOBER 13, 2009**

**ADOPTED BY COUNCIL – OCTOBER 27, 2009**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES TO THE CITY OF PITTSBURGH FOR THE SEPTEMBER 24-25 G-20 SUMMIT; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS PROVIDED BY PENNSYLVANIA LAW.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor and proper officers of the City be and hereby are authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for the Provision of Services and Aid in Preparation for and during the G-20 Summit with the City of Pittsburgh, a copy of which Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement For the Provision of Services and Aid in Preparation for and During the G-20 Summit shall be referred to herein as the “Agreement”.

**SECTION 2.** The Agreement sets forth the terms pursuant to which the City of Lancaster shall provide law enforcement support through personnel and equipment to the City of Pittsburgh for the G-20 Summit to be held September 24, and September 25, 2009 at the David Lawrence Convention Center and other venues in the City of Pittsburgh. The term of the Agreement shall commence as of the date of the Agreement and terminate when all of the obligations of both parties under and pursuant to the Agreement are terminated.

**SECTION 3.** The City of Pittsburgh will be paying the City of Lancaster directly for services rendered and no financing of the Agreement shall be required.

**SECTION 4.** No new organizational structure is necessary to implement the Agreement. The officers and equipment of the City will be operating under the supervision of the law enforcement agent designated in the Agreement by the City of Pittsburgh.

**SECTION 5.** The Agreement does not call for the acquisition, management license or disposal of equipment or property.

SECTION 6. The parties to the Agreement have specifically agreed to be responsible for retaining their own insurance policies for their employees involved in the G-20 Summit.

SECTION 7. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance; it being the intent of the City of Lancaster that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
