ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE NO. 14 – 2009

ADMINISTRATION BILL NO. 14 - 2009

INTRODUCED – OCTOBER 13, 2009

ADOPTED BY COUNCIL – OCTOBER 27, 2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SHARED IT SERVICES WITH THE COUNTY OF LANCASTER; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS PROVIDED BY PENNSYLVANIA LAW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and proper officers of the City be and hereby are authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for the provision of IT Services with the County of Lancaster, a copy of which Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A” and which shall be referred to herein as the “Agreement”.

SECTION 2. The Agreement sets forth the terms pursuant to which the City and County shall work together to eliminate the duplication and redundancy related to the Information Technology Services provided by both the City and the County. The term of the Agreement shall commence as of the date of the Agreement and shall continue for twelve months thereafter with automatic renewals of one-year periods thereafter unless either party gives the other six months written notice of its intent to terminate. The City will be paying the County of Lancaster directly for services rendered and no financing of the Agreement shall be required.

SECTION 3. No new organizational structure is necessary to implement the Agreement.

SECTION 4. In accordance with the Agreement, each of the City and the County agrees to purchase any and all necessary software licenses related to the consolidated Information Technology Services and to purchase any and all necessary hardware related to the same.

SECTION 5. The Agreement does not empower either party to enter into contracts for policies of group insurance and employee benefits. Rather, the employees involved in this Agreement shall be insured by their respective employers; namely the City of Lancaster and/or the County of Lancaster.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions insofar as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and rescinded.

SECTION 7. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance; it being the intent of the City of Lancaster that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
