**ADMINISTRATION ORDINANCE NO.**

**ADMINISTRATION BILL NO. 14 - 2008**

**INTRODUCED - NOVEMBER 11, 2008**

**ADOPTED BY COUNCIL -**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTERS 100 AND 256 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF BICYCLES AND SKATEBOARDS ON SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN INVESTMENT DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVING THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS PROVIDED BY PENNSYLVANIA LAW.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the City of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, Chapter 100 - Bicycles, Section 100-10-Riding or Parking to Obstruct Pedestrians, Subpart B, be and hereby is amended to read as follow:

"B. No person shall ride a bicycle on the sidewalk of that part of the district of the City of Lancaster known as the Downtown Investment District as defined in Ordinance No. 11-2000, except for members of the Bureau of Police, including the Chief of Police, while on duty, and except for employees of the Lancaster Downtown Investment District Authority serving as bicycle patrol while on dut, when required for emergency action and/or law enforcement activities."

**SECTION 2.** The Code of the City of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, Chapter 256-Skateboards, Section 256-4-Rules of the Road, Subpart D, be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"D. No person or pedestrian shall ride or operate a skateboard on a sidewalk in the Downtown Investment District of the City of Lancaster as defined in Ordinance No. 11-2000. The Lancaster City Traffic Commission is authorized to approve official signage on those roadways where skateboarding shall be designated as prohibited."

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions insofar as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and rescinded.

**SECTION 4.** In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance; it being the intent of the City of Lancaster that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
