ADMINISTRATION BILL NO.13 - 2010

INTRODUCED –JULY 13, 2010

ADOPTED BY COUNCIL –

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING, AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT OF SALE BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF LANCASTER AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LANCASTER PURSUANT TO WHICH THE CITY WILL SELL BICYCLES WHICH THE CITY HAS OBTAINED FROM ABANDONMENT, THEFT OR LOSS TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LANCASTER IN ORDER FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE THEM TO A COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION THAT WILL TRAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENTS IN BASIC JOB SKILLS AND BICYCLE REPAIR; SETTING FORTH THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING, THAT NO FINANCING NOR ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE IS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT OR FINANCE THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS PROVIDED BY PENNSYLVANIA LAW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. The proper officials of the City of Lancaster be and hereby are authorized to enter into an Agreement of Sale by and between the City of Lancaster and the School District of Lancaster attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A” and/or their previous execution of the same be and hereby is ratified and approved.

SECTION 2. The terms of the Agreement are incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. The Agreement shall expire upon transfer of the City’s bicycles to the School District.

SECTION 4. No financing nor organizational structure is needed to implement the Agreement and the Agreement specifically provides for the manner in which the City’s bicycles shall be disposed of; namely, they shall be acquired by the School District and donated to the community organization training School District’s students in basic job skills and bicycle repair. Further, no entity will be created under this Agreement.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions insofar as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and rescinded.

SECTION 6. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance; it being the intent of the City of Lancaster that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
