

General Pool Rules

The following rules and regulations have been established for the benefit and protection of all users of the Central Park Swimming Pool.

- All patrons must present a valid season pass, or pay the daily admission rate upon entering the pool - **No Exceptions.**
- **The Central Park Swimming Pool does not offer rain checks or refunds for any reason. This includes inclement weather.**
- Alcoholic beverages or persons under the influence of alcohol will not be permitted in the pool complex, surrounding areas, or any part of Central Park. Use of such will result in immediate expulsion from the park.
- The use of abusive or profane language or other improper conduct on pool property shall be grounds for expulsion.
- Glass containers of any kind are prohibited in the pool facility.
- Children under 4 years of age are required to wear swim diapers. Disposable swim diapers may be purchased at the front desk.
- No dogs, cats, or other pets are allowed within the pool complex.
- Diving, running, pushing, dunking and horseplay are strictly prohibited.
- **Children under 55 inches must be supervised by an adult age 16 or over. Children under 55 inches who present a valid Middle School or Junior High School I.D. may be admitted without supervision.**
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are permitted in the pool complex.
- Public address equipment may be used only to deliver messages of an emergency nature - absolutely no paging.
- Patrons are requested to leave valuables at home. The management is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Patrons are not to visit or engage in unnecessary conversations with lifeguards while they are on duty.
- Proper bathing attire is required. Blue jeans, cut-offs and gym shorts are not permitted. T-shirts may be worn for medical reasons and must first be approved by the Pool Manager.
- The use of noise-making devices such as whistles, sirens, horns, long-range speakers, etc., are prohibited in and around the immediate pool premises.
- Young children must be supervised at all times.
- At any time, the Central Park Swimming Pool staff may make a request of a patron that is not written explicitly in the rules. Please keep in mind that the staff has patron safety as the primary consideration.
- Disobeying pool staff will result in immediate ejection from the facility.
- A pool pass or valid Driver's License must be rendered in order to borrow recreation equipment.
