

Lancaster County Prescription Drug Discount Card Program

Beginning in June 2009, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners will offer residents of Lancaster County a FREE prescription drug discount card. The Lancaster County Department of Parks and Recreation is pleased to partner with the Commissioners by making the Lancaster County Prescription Drug Discount Card available for you to pick up in our Lancaster County Central Park Office located at 1050 Rockford Road, Lancaster.

The Lancaster County Prescription Discount Card will provide a discount on prescriptions not covered by another health plan at any of the 91 participating pharmacies in Lancaster County or 59,000 participating pharmacies Nationwide.

Any county resident without prescription coverage can use this program. However, even if you have insurance for prescription drugs, you may still benefit from the card by receiving a discount on prescription drugs your existing plan does not cover.

There are no eligibility requirements, enrollment forms, or membership fees to use the Lancaster County Prescription Drug Discount Card. Simply pick up a card and take it to a participating pharmacy to receive a discount. One card can be used for the whole family!
