<u>Purpose:</u>	To increase the amount of the contract to reflect actual service utilization. Playtime Therapy provides physical therapy services to children ranging in age from infant to 3 years old.
<u>Amount/Term:</u>	\$49,113.08 for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026. Increase of \$14,128.38, 40.38%.
<u>Funding:</u>	90% State base funding and 10% County funding.

On motion of Commissioner Yoder, seconded by Commissioner Parsons, it was agreed for the County of Lancaster, acting on behalf of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (BHDS), to approve the following:

<u>Amended Agreement With:</u>	Billings Bilingual Lancaster, PA
<u>Purpose:</u>	To increase the amount of the contract to reflect actual service utilization. Billings Bilingual provides document translation for the Early Intervention Team working with families of children from infancy to 3 years old.
<u>Amount/Term:</u>	\$29,700.00 for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026. Increase of \$4,410.00, 17.44%.
<u>Funding:</u>	90% State base funding and 10% County funding.

<u>Amended Grant Agreement With:</u>	Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency Harrisburg, PA
<u>Purpose:</u>	To approve changes to the standard terms in the Radiation Emergency Response Fund (RERF) grant agreement, which was previously approved by the Commissioners on March 25. The grant will be used to offset the planner's salary who is working directly on the opening of the Crane Clean Energy Center, formerly TMI.
<u>Amount/Term</u>	\$36,353.00 for the period March 25, 2026, through July 30, 2027.
<u>Funding:</u>	Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency funds.
<u>Note:</u>	To give Brian P. Pasquale, Executive Director, authorization to sign the grant agreement.
