Commissioner D'Agostino called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Commissioner D'Agostino announced that an executive session was held yesterday, September 11, 2023, at 2:20 p.m. to discuss a personnel matter and this morning, September 12, 2023, at 9:20 a.m. to discuss a personnel matter and two cases in Eastern District Court of Pennsylvania: the Morant case, docket No. 5:23-CB-00054-JBW and the Smooth Vape case, docket No. 5:23-CB-C03000-EGS.

Commissioner D'Agostino announced that the Commissioners' meeting will be held tonight at 7 p.m. at the Eden Township Municipal Building, 489 Stony Hill Road, Quarryville.

Commissioner D'Agostino announced approval of the September 5, 2023, Work Session Minutes.

1. Mr. Shiffer, Deputy Warden, and Ms. Fluegel, Reentry Services Manager, presented an Agreement with Donegal Substance Abuse Alliance (DSSA).

Mr. Stuhldreher asked how many individuals post release they plan to help serving.

2. Mr. Leppler, Sheriff, presented Resolution No. 63 of 2023: Fifth Extension Agreement with Schaad Detective Agency.

Mr. Leppler said his office is still 12 full-time deputies short and eight part-time deputies short.

Commissioner Parsons asked if it was possible to continue to step down the contract with Schaad. Leppler said that is his plan but he recently had four deputies come back from training at the academy, five who just left for training and six leaving for the academy in January.

Commissioner Trescot suggested that if the County is going to continue to use Schaad in 2024 that that cost be put into the budget so ARPA funds will not have to continue to be used.

3. Mr. Leppler, Sheriff, presented a Change Order with Teleosoft Corporation.
4. Ms. Pfursich, Solicitor, presented an Amended Motion for Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Lancaster County Detective Association.
5. Mr. George, County Administrator/Chief Clerk, presented Resolution No. 64 of 2023: Lancaster County Human Services Block Grant (HSBG) narrative Plan for Fiscal Year 2023-2024.
6. Other Discussion Items: Board Appointment – Lancaster County Convention Center Authority.
