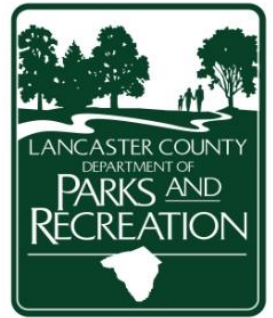

\$55 per camper, ages 4 & 5

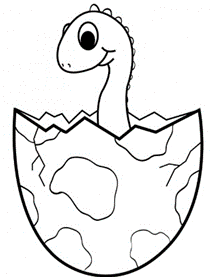

Campers will learn about the types of dinosaurs that roamed the land, how scientists uncover the truth about dinosaurs, and ways in which dinosaurs resemble present-day wildlife.



Explorers: Ages 6 – 8



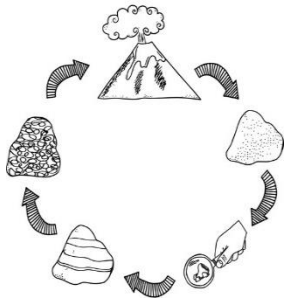
Outdoor Explorers

June 21st – 25th from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (Pavilion 2)

\$90 per camper, age 6-8; must have completed kindergarten

Let's go explore! With stream nets, bug nets, maps, compasses, and binoculars in hand, campers will explore the streams, rivers, fields, and woods of Central Park. Campers will navigate using map and compass, complete a team scavenger hunt, determine water quality, and identify plants and insects to avoid. Campers will also enjoy playing Capture the Flag and swimming in the park pool between their adventures.

Camp GEO

Camp Geo is the perfect camp for budding geologists! Children will hike to discover Central Park geology, collect rocks, and test the physical properties of minerals. We will discover that sands are not all the same, and exercise creativity with sand art and pet rocks.

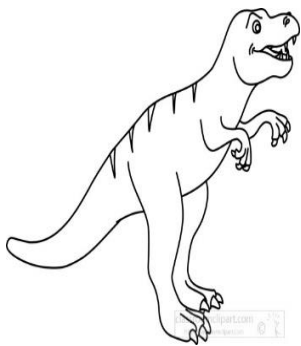
Child vs. Wild

Week 1: July 12th – 16th from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (Pavilion 21)

Week 2: August 9th – 13th from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (Pavilion 21)

\$90 per camper, ages 6-8; must have completed kindergarten

Welcome to Survival Camp for younger children - perfect for the budding outdoorsperson! Shelters that children build will function as their bases for the week as they learn about the woods and water nearby. Campers will practice survival skills including navigation, knot-tying, basic first aid, and common sense. The week will end with a "Survival Olympics" in which groups apply skills practiced during the week.



The World of Dinosaurs

July 19th- 23rd from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (Pavilion 2)

\$90 per camper, ages 6-8; must have completed kindergarten

What did dinosaurs see as they looked around their world? Based on what scientists know from fossil clues, campers will explore dinosaurs' shapes, sounds, sizes, roles of predator and prey, and more. Along the way, campers will apply newfound knowledge to create their own make-believe dinosaurs giving them names, descriptions, and behaviors consistent with the world in which they lived.

Summer Spectacular

August 2nd – 6th from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (Pavilion 2)

\$90 per camper, ages 6-8; must have completed kindergarten

Summer Spectacular will focus on classic games and favorite summer camp activities. Campers will play Capture the Flag, Freeze Tag, and Spud. Children will enjoy fishing, exploring the creek, hiking, and swimming in the Central Park Pool with newfound friends. In quieter moments, children will make tie-dye shirts, launch water bottle rockets, and make ice cream in a bag. Come join in Summer Spectacular for spectacular fun!



Intermediate: Ages 9 - 11



Survival in Central Park

Week 1: June 28th – July 2nd from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Pavilion 21)

Week 2: July 19th – July 23rd from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Pavilion 21)

\$160 per week, per camper, ages 9 - 11

If you like to play and learn in the woods, this is the camp for you! Campers will be outside all week while they learn and practice survival skills including shelter building, fire-starting, campfire cooking, navigation, water purification, basic first aid, wild edibles, signaling for help, and creating a survival kit to take home.

Best of Summer

July 12th – 16th from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Pavilion 2)

\$160 per camper, ages 9 - 11

Best of Summer Camp packs the best summer fun into one week! Campers will go creek stumping and fishing. They will build and launch water rockets, swim in the Central Park pool, learn how to properly build and light a fire, participate in a team-based scavenger hunt, make ice cream in a bag, and play Capture the Flag and other classic games. Campers will have a blast making new friends and fun memories along the way!



Ultimate: Ages 11 - 13

Ultimate Explorer

July 26th – 30th from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Pavilion 2)

\$170 per camper, ages 11 to 13

The goal of finding a primitive homesteading site that fulfills basic needs will guide campers' active exploration of Central Park. Working as a team, campers will apply skills in map-reading, navigation, fishing, shelter-building, water quality assessment, primitive cooking, and identification of local flora and fauna toward their goal. Dips in the Central Park pool on warm summer afternoons will remind campers of modern-day comforts!
