Project/Item Description	<p>1. Linstown Road project. Install new storm sewer system to include storm sewer pipes and catch basin to meet MS4 requirements.</p> <p>2. Clearview Rd project. Upgrade storm sewer system currently in place to meet MS4 requirements. Remove and replace storm sewer pipe and add catch basin</p>
Estimated Cost – how cost was derived & provision of partner funds (who is providing, how much and show commitments).	<p>Project # 1 Linstown Rd Project. \$43,000.00 (County Funds) Cost of materials i.e. Aggregate, oversized catch basins, pipe, rental of special equipment (track hoe, pumps), permits and engineering fees. Pequea Township to provide labor (estimated 380 hrs. = \$15,200.00) and equipment (dump trucks, backhoe, skid loader, wheel loader. Project # 2. Clearview Rd Project. \$4,500.00 (County Funds) Cost of materials i.e. Aggregate, catch basins, pipe. Township to provide labor (estimated 160 hrs. = \$6,400.00) and equipment (dump trucks, back hoe, skid loader).</p>
Which County ARPA Community-wide Benefit(s) does the project meet?	Infrastructure (storm sewers) and Clean water.
Briefly explain how the project meets the County's guidelines.	<p>The project will fall under the County Guideline #2 <u>Clean water / natural area conversation initiatives</u>, the project will assist with the township meeting the MS4 requirements. Pequea Township is currently under a waiver for MS4. This project will help control erosion being caused along Linstown Road therefore allowing for a cleaner water transmission from roadway to the stream water. This project will upgrade the current infrastructure better meeting today's standards. Project will not require additional funding for ongoing maintenance. Funding cost of project would be from township funds and the ARPA grant.</p>
Why should this project be a priority and how will it help the County? Also, if this application is for more than one project, please identify each one, provide information and rank them in order of your priority.	<p>This project should be a priority due to assisting in the transmission of erosion to a cleaner water transfer into stream water. Slowing/eliminating the erosion will assist in preventing soil sediment from entering streams. There are two projects listed for this application. The priority is the Linstown Road Project (Project # 1). The second project would be the Clearview Road Project.</p>
Will this project require ongoing expense (maintenance, updates) or frequent replacement? Are expenses already being incurred, if so, can they be reduced through this project?	<p>Neither project will require ongoing maintenance. The current expenses being incurred are the repairs to the edge of the road caused by the erosion. Upon completion of this project it will eliminate the need for continual repairs.</p>
