

Act 48 of 2015 information for candidates filing Nomination Petitions or Papers for the office of Tax Collector (or city/ first class township treasurer) with the Lancaster County Board of Elections.

Candidates who do not currently hold the office of tax collector or who have not previously held the office of tax collector are required to file a copy of a report of criminal history record information obtained from the Pennsylvania State Police with their nomination petition (or paper).

Candidates who currently hold the office of tax collector or who have previously held the office of tax collector are not required to file the criminal history record information with their petition (or paper).

The criminal history record report must be dated within one year of the date the candidate is filing the nomination petition (or paper).

Candidates who have not been a resident of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for two years immediately preceding the filing of the petition (or paper) must provide a federal criminal history record information with the petition (or paper) instead of one obtained from the Pennsylvania State Police.
