Who May Enter:

Any student in grades K-12 who is a resident of Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. For judging purposes, posters will be divided into 4 categories and memes into 2 categories. The divisions are: Posters and Memes judged and awarded in the following divisions:

Division (#1) – Grades K -- 2;
Division (#2) – Grades 3 -- 5; Division 3) Grades 6
- 8;
Division #3 – Grades 6 – 8
Division #4 -- Grades 9 -12

Division #1 – Grades 6 – 8
Division #2 – Grades 9 - 12

Deadline Date:

Completed poster/meme designs Completed posters/memes must be postmarked by **March 1619, 2018**. All entries will become the property of the Lancaster County C.A.S.E. Task Force and will not be returned. Entries may be modified for reproduction..

Theme:

Each poster/meme must represent the theme “**Respect Yourself**” to be eligible to win. This year’s theme, carries on C.A.S.E.’s “Think B4 U Post” internet safety campaign and is intended to make youth stop and think about the serious social and sometimes criminal dangers associated with posting online. In today’s digital world there are an alarming number of youth, including here in Lancaster County, who are posting inappropriate messages and pictures on the internet. Sometimes these posts hurt others or put themselves in danger. Other times, these posts are criminal acts that can result in criminal charges. Posting online is a serious responsibility and one in which we hope our community as a whole will aid in offering education. Poster/Memes Specifications:

- ❖ Completed poster/memes size must be 11” X 17” or 12” X 18” ONLY. Posters may be illustrated on the vertical or horizontal axis. Memes should be in jpg format made using Photo Editor app., which can be downloaded for free to Android and Apple products.
- ❖ Completed poster/ memes contest entry forms should be securely glued to the **back of the poster**. Meme entry forms should be emailed with a digital meme submission or printed and provided with a flash drive submission. Please print clearly.
- ❖ **Illustrations should be positive in approach and illustrate the theme “Respect Yourself”.**
- ❖ Poster/memes themes must be original and the exclusive work of the student entering the contest in idea, design and execution and **may not incorporate any copyrighted images (i.e. comic, and/or television characters, magazine or newspaper illustrations)**. Memes may include **ORIGINAL** photographs and images but **may not contain any faces or other identifying parts of a person, inappropriate images and/or language, real**

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For Posters, there is no limitation on the type of media – such as print, crayon, felt pen, paint etc. – that can be used on the poster design. **However, please do not use any materials that protrude from the poster. Posters may not include photographs, magazine or newspaper illustrations.**

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Memes may include ORIGINAL photographs and images but may not contain any faces or other identifying parts of a person, inappropriate images and/or language, real or suggestive.

All memes should be in PDF format.

Criteria for the selection of award-winning posters/memes are:

- A. Relationship of the poster design to the theme "There is No Delete Button Respect Yourself"
- B. Originality of the poster/meme and how the idea is expressed in the poster design.
- C. Artwork and its execution.
- D. Visual impact of the poster design/meme.

All rules regarding poster specification, themes, lettering, etc., must be followed to qualify for prizes.

All entries become the property of the Lancaster County C.A.S.E. Task Force which reserves the right to modify any poster/meme for reproduction.

All entries postmarked or received by **March 169, 2018** will be acknowledged by the CASE Task Force.
